WILDLIFE PHOTOGRAPHER, CARL SAMS PRESENTING AT 4TH ANNUAL PHOTOSHOP SOUP2NUTS 2.006 CONFERENCE ON JUNE 23 AND 24

The Fourth Annual Photoshop Soup2Nuts 2.006 Conference is returning to Ann Arbor on June 23 and 24, at Washtenaw Community College. The Conference is a two day learning conference encompassing the entire genre of digital imaging workflow.

Carl Sams, of Milford, Michigan, is a professional wildlife photographer. Sams, along with his colleague, Jean Stoick, have appeared in hundreds of national and international publications. Honored recipients of the People's Choice Award for the best of show 11 times at major wildlife exhibits, Carl and Jean were also the first photographers ever to be honored as featured artists at a major wildlife art event.

Widely known for their New York Times #1 best-seller, "Stranger in the Woods," the photographers' first children's book, was released in the fall of 1999. The book uses the couple's photographs to tell the story of resident birds and deer reacting to a snowman that appears in the winter woods.

Carl will be hosting a mini-session and book signing.

The Photoshop Soup2Nuts2.006 conference is open to anyone from the remotely interested in digital imaging, graphic design, videography, 3D animation and the arts to those who want to influence future development of Photoshop itself. Many extra conference events add to the opportunity of interacting with folks, who not only wrote the books and software, but are happy to let participants in on the secrets.
